| 1. Be Prepared! | 1. Don't bring electronics – no GameBoys – no IPODS – no cell phones |
| 2. Bring Mess kit | 2. Don't bring food for tent – Wild animals will visit |
| 3. Bring personal First Aid kit | 3. Don't go off alone – remember the buddy system |
| 4. Wear Class A uniform to travel to campout | 4. Don't bring anything valuable |
| 5. Bring Scout Book | 5. Don't wear cotton next to your skin--long underwear should not be cotton--polypropylene, capilene or silk are best. Sock liners should be synthetic as well. |
| 6. Bring Rain gear (extra shoes & socks too!) | 6. Don't harass or feed the wildlife |
| 7. Be prepared for freezing temperatures | 7. Don't waste good water. |
| 8. Bring water bottle for hiking | 8. Don't leave your tent open when unattended. |
| 9. Pack everything in plastic bags | 9. Don't wear jeans!! (see #5 above) |
| 10. Dress in layers | 10. Do not discard any food in natural areas--including fruit peels |
| 11. Bring bug repellent | 11. Don't pick plants or hang on/climb trees. |
| 12. Bring sun screen | 12. Don't leave a Troop activity or camp without notifying an adult leader and receiving permission. |
| 13. Good flashlight with extra batteries | |
